From the Winery: Eberle Winery was not Gary Eberle's first wine venture when he arrived in Paso Robles, California. After finishing his coursework for a Ph.D. in Enology and Viticulture at U.C. Davis, Eberle moved to Paso Robles and began his career by co-founding the Estrella River Winery in 1973. After several successful years as the winemaker, Eberle refocused his attention and desire to produce premium, small production wine. Moving only a few miles down the highway Eberle soon started his own prestigious label which debuted officially with the release of Eberle's flagship wine, the 1979 Cabernet Sauvignon. Since then, he has earned recognition for many firsts in the wine industry including co-founding the Paso Robles Appellation in 1983, being the first to list the Paso Robles Appellation on his label, and being the first to produce a 100% commercially produced Syrah.

**Appearance:**  
The bottle is so cool. Sophisticated under the radar twist cap, the familiar gold leaf boar (symbol of the family), and the very informative back label makes you relate to the winery. I am friends with winemaker Chris Eberle, and quite proud to offer this great wine. It is a gorgeous metallic silver/gold hue, looking youthful.

**Nose:**  
Lychee nut, apricot and peach are forward on the nose. Really superb aromatics, including honeysuckle, citrus blossom and fresh ginger.

**Texture:**  
Lovely, sweet fruit entry is well-balanced and has a perfect line of acid to keep it making your mouth water. Medium full in body and weight, with. Long, extended, fruit filled finish.

**Flavor:**  
It is just delicious! Apricot, peach and lychee nut are most prominent on the palate. Ginger notes are stronger in the middle and toward the end of the mouthfeel, leaving a slightly sharp edge cutting the fruit intensity perfectly. Grapefruit finish. KILLER!

**Serving Suggestions:**  
Just sipping on this wine is such a pleasure, especially at this price point. I suggest taking a case home and drink it through to the end of the year.
